2016/2017 Zip Code Priorities

Any expansion funds through the Child Development Division (CDD) of the California Department of Education must go to the most underserved areas of California. In order for Marin County to be considered for expansion funding for General Child Care and State Preschool Program, **the Marin County Child Care Commission must identify the most underserved areas in our county by zip code.**



2016/2017 Zip Code Priorities

By May 30 of each year, upon approval by the County Board of Supervisors and the County Superintendent of Schools, the **Commission shall submit to CDD the local priorities it has identified that reflect all child care needs in the county.**

The priority zip codes are determined on the basis of a demand and supply analysis performed with California Department of Education (CDE), California Department of Social Services (CDSS), Early Head Start and Head Start (EHS/HS), American Institutes for Research (AIR) and census data.

In the draft Marin 2016 Report, it is indicates that the following priorities submitted to CDD in 2015 are still valid and no change is needed.
